Season of Advent

My dear children of God, welcome to the season of joy, hope and love. Advent is a time for us to understand that God is always doing something new for us. Unlike the commencement of the New Year, the Universal Church begins its new liturgical year on the first Sunday of Advent. With this newness comes the revelation of seeing the world with fresh eyes so we can view the future and God's divine plan for us more clearly.

Advent is all about watching and waiting. The word 'advent' comes from the Latin adventus, which means 'coming' or 'arrival'. We are called during this holy season of advent to wait with anticipation knowing the joys of what is to come with the arrival of Christ. This is the time we come together, celebrate together, and share our gifts with joy to our loved ones.

During Advent, we practise the discipline of opening our hearts to the presence of Christ in our midst; we wait for a glimpse of the Emmanuel which means that he is with us; we long to experience the joy of his presence and the wonder of the love of our God, who became flesh and dwelt amongst us and whose Spirit is with us, encouraging us to join in the living of God's Kingdom now.

Advent shed light into the shadows of our lives as we pray through these days towards Christmas. This is a time to stretch and arouse our imagination for the Lord's coming as saviour and new-born child. And we do so in the radiance of candles lit on the Advent Wreath, seeking deeper meaning to our faith set shimmering by the Holy Spirit in the truth of our living, and showers us with the blessedness of our Heavenly Father.

Our task during the Advent season is to imitate Mary by pondering the Word of God and allowing it to resonate within our hearts and pour into our lives.

Over four weeks this resource provides the opportunity for us to encounter the mystery of Christ present in the Advent Gospels and artwork. We are invited to gather, encounter, recall, reflect, share, connect and consider how we will live differently as a result of what we have experienced. By being together with our stories, our questions, our open hearts and minds, we can form a community that lifts, honours, and learns from each other as we are sent out with anticipation and joy this Advent season.

This artwork (which was chosen to be the face of the Archdiocesan face for the Reconciliation Action Plan) was painted by Shara Delaney a descendant of the Noonuccal, Ngugi and Goenpul clan groups of Quandamooka. It represents the Archdiocese of Brisbane as the face of the Catholic Church of Southeast Queensland. Shara's design shows the journey of faith, which is guided by the Spirit. It is depicted where the blue meets the green, and that main path represents the journey of faith which is heading towards the centre. It's the spirit figure that is guiding them. The main circle also represents the Archdiocese of Brisbane's community as a whole. From the centre, it branches out to the smaller circles to support and stay connected to the vulnerable in our communities. The white dots are the healing power (coming from the spirit) which is highlighted throughout the design. Shara placed the smaller circles to represent different people throughout the community and to be seen as inclusive. The little figure in the smaller circles is her interpretation of a person, using Aboriginal symbols. The black lines that flow in the background represents the spreading the good news simply and effectively. she really enhanced the main circle with layers and dots, to express governance structures and systems in bright colours as being responsive and innovative.


