## **Pentecost Sunday**

**19th / 20th May 2018**

*Originally a letter to sent to the Clergy of the Archdiocese from Archbishop Mark, I am passing this on with some minor edits, as it is relevant for us all. Thank you for your attention to Archbishop's Mark's direction to us for the Plenary Council of 2020. Fr David.*

Dear Brothers (and Sisters) ,

This year as we celebrate Pentecost we will also officially launch the journey of the Plenary Council. The journey really began back in May 2016 when the bishops decided to move towards the Council, and now after two years of preparation we are in a position to have a more formal launch.

I would ask that you make the Plenary Council an integral element of all Masses on this weekend. ... There is also a Plenary Council Prayer which could be prayed at the end of the Prayer of the Faithful, not only this weekend but perhaps at Sunday Masses each week as we journey to the Council and beyond. For more detail you might consult the Plenary Council website at [plenarycouncil.catholic.org.au](http://plenarycouncil.catholic.org.au) where there is much information and various resources.

It is essential that the Plenary Council be seen not as administrative or political but as spiritual and ecclesial. The decision was made by the bishops but under the influence of the Holy Spirit; and the Holy Spirit will have to be our guide at every step of the journey. We are drawn into a process of discernment of what God is asking of us in Australia at this time, and that process will demand deep and constant prayer – a listening to God – from the entire Catholic community.

The Church was born of the Spirit at Pentecost, and we are now in search of a new birth as we look to the future. Birth can be painful and messy, but if this process is the work of the Holy Spirit it will lead to peace and hope and joy.

Beyond this Pentecost launch, I urge you and your people to enter wholeheartedly into the consultation process which now begins, so that as many voices as possible can be heard as we seek to shape the Plenary Council agenda. Keep in mind that the journey of the Council has three phases: preparation, celebration and implementation. The preparation phase has already begun; the Council will be celebrated in two sessions, one in October 2020 and the other is early 2021; and the implementation phase will stretch far beyond that.

In the Archdiocese I have convened a Plenary Council Task Force, who will promote and coordinate all our efforts at the local level and who will work closely with the national Plenary Council Executive Committee. Each bishop has also been asked to name two people to be part of a national network of local representatives. You might consider nominating someone in the parish to be the point of contact for the Plenary Council.

I might also mention that in the second half of 2019 there will be an Archdiocesan Assembly to prepare for the Plenary Council, and the Archdiocesan Task Force will oversee the preparation of this.

So the journey has already begun, and we pray this weekend that the Holy Spirit who has inspired us to begin this great work will guide us on the way and bring us to a point where our mind and heart are one with God's. Peace be with you.
