Twenty-Eighth Sunday In Ordinary Time

12th / 13th October 2019

Welcoming our brothers and sisters home through RCIA Program (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

The RCIA program (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a journey that takes about 6 to 9 months. It involves meeting every week or fortnight in a small group to discuss topics that have been read previously (you would be given a resource that you read, reflect on, wrestle with etc.) and to ask any questions you may have.

Here in our parish, we have put together a team of parishioners who would act as catechists in the group and they are there to help you understand the Catholic faith and tradition. The initiation of catechumens is a gradual process that takes place within the community of the faithful. The entire community are encouraged to help the candidates and the catechumens throughout the process of initiation.

Catechumens are encouraged to attend mass every week (although they would not be able to receive Holy Communion) in order to experience liturgy and to become familiar with Catholic worship. This period is called the period of the Catechumenate (Catechumens are those people who have never been baptised) and is a time of discerning their beliefs, and for the nurturing and growth of their faith and conversion to God and educating themselves about the Catholic faith.

The RCIA program covers such topics as Prayer, the Sacraments of the Church, the Structure of the Mass, the Moral Law, the Life of Faith and many other subjects over a number of months leading to reception of the sacraments at the Easter Vigil. Each session involves discussion and formation in the faith and enables everyone involved, candidates, sponsors and catechists to contemplate and deepen their faith in a relaxed and supportive environment.

On the First Sunday of Lent (church season), once candidates have spent some months meeting in the small group and coming to mass and joining with our community, then they would go to St Stephen's Cathedral in the city (along with all the other people from around Brisbane who are part of the RCIA journey) and they would formally express their desire to receive the sacraments, through a ceremony called the Rite of election.

The next few months called the period of Purification and Enlightenment is a time of reflection, intensely centred on conversion, marked by celebrations of certain rites during the mass. On Easter Saturday night, the elect are initiated through Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist.

The period following Easter, is called the post baptismal catechesis and is when you experience being fully a part of the Christian Community by means of both catechesis (teaching) and particularly by participation with all the faithful in the Sunday Eucharistic celebration.

We are delighted to announce that presently we have six candidates who enrolled in this year's RCIA programme from our Caboolture community and we believe there may be few more out there, especially from Beachmere and Bribie communities.
