

St Paul was a great letter writer. The words above, that we hear today from his first letter to the Christian community in Corinth, are echoed throughout his various communications with the churches he founded and continued to form, as an apostle, as he notes, "appointed by God." However, in the part of the letter we hear today, St Paul also includes his "brother Sosthenes," in his greeting to the community. Reading through the Acts of the Apostles and his own letters there are many other companions of St Paul mentioned: Barnabes, Epaphdras, Gaius, Jason of Thessalonica, John Mark, Onesimus, Sila, just to name a few!

Paul did not carry out his mission in the Mediterranean world alone! Paul's life as an apostle was one of collaboration with others. To spread the Good News of Jesus Christ was certainly not a solitary affair, and through God's grace he called others to participate with him in his venture to spread the Living Word!

With St Paul, hopefully, this is our way in these days. As the Church, especially since Vatican II, and in the light of Pope Francis' leadership, we too are a community of collaboration as we seek to respond with the Psalmist from today's reading: Here I am, Lord I/we come to do your will!

In 2015 Pope Francis was speaking at Mass and said: One of the great challenges facing the Church in this generation is to foster in all the faithful a sense of personal responsibility for the Church's mission, and to enable them to fulfill that responsibility as missionary disciples, as a leaven of the Gospel in our world. This will require creativity in adapting to changed situations, carrying forward the legacy of the past not primarily by maintaining our structures and institutions, which have served us well, but above all by being open to the possibilities which the Spirit opens up to us and communicating the joy of the Gospel, daily and in every season of our life.

In the midst of the challenges we face as the Church here today as a new Parish, it is near time to begin the process of forming both a new Parish Pastoral Council and Parish Finance Council. Together as representatives of our various communities, along with myself and Fr Lucius, I hope that we can look forward and act with creativity as we follow the possibilities that the Spirit of Jesus presents to us to live and communicate the Gospel to our part of the world. I hope that you would first pray for the formation of these respective councils that we are inclusive of representatives who will provide both a vision and ways of acting that are graced by God's will. Second, you might pray about, ponder those who could best fulfil these roles, possibly yourself included.

There will be more soon on the process for the formation of our Councils for the collaboration in the spreading of God's ways.
