Exploring the Beatitudes

Today, the Holy Mother Church celebrates the solemnity of All Saints, which is the feast of our future birth in heaven in commemoration in faith of our sisters and brothers who have achieved eternal beatitudes before us. Once again in Matthew's Gospel, Jesus provides us with the model through which we can attain the Beatific vision. The word beatitude comes from the Latin word *beati* meaning "the happy ones" or "the ones being blessed."

These Beatitudes are also ways by which we become channels of good news of Christ to other people. These are the ideals by which the saints showed their closeness to God's expectations. The eight beatitudes outline the virtues, the Constitution of the Kingdom of God that makes us true Disciples of Christ. These beatitudes are in constant opposite with the values promoted by the world. According to Christina Astorga in her *Living the Faith Option*, and quoted by Fr. Raul Caga, SVD in Bible Diary 2007, beatitudes stress the following values:

1. To be poor in spirit requires a humble recognition that one's life must be lived in radical dependence on the goodness and providence of God.
2. Mourning is in dying to ourselves for others to live, that we rise to new life and to the fundamental meaning of dying and living in Christ.
3. True meekness comes from the gentleness of spirit in a person united with God, who is filled not only with the passion to right the wrong but also the compassion to offer renewal to the wrongdoer.
4. The deepest hunger and thirst of the humble heart is the realization of the righteousness of God in justice.
5. Mercy means more than pity. It is an action which entails the movement of one's heart for the suffering of others in a true and genuine caring for them.
6. To be pure of heart is to centre one's life on God through one's concern and compassion for others.
7. Peace is founded on love, justice and truth. When one of these human values is violated, peace is not attained.
8. A suffering born of love and commitment is a suffering which is truly united with the suffering of the Crucified Christ.

Dear brothers and sisters, let us remember that the celebration of the Solemnity of All Saints is not only a celebration of those saints, declared and not declared but also for all of us who are on our way to becoming saints. Though we are on our pilgrim stage, but so long as we continue to persevere in the face of sorrow and pain till the end, our perseverance will ultimately win us our lives. Yes, if they can do it, we can do it too.
