## Sunday of the word of God

Today the Church in Australia celebrates the Sunday of the Word of God, as Pope Francis last year instituted the celebration when issuing the apostolic letter *Aperuit Illis*. The letter encouraged the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God throughout the world.

### Jesus' Mission

Once again in Mark's Gospel today Jesus demonstrates to us that his mission is to bring us total freedom of body and soul, as he goes about doing good. This part of Mark's Gospel equally completes a picture of Jesus' messianic ministry: preaching, curing the sick, driving out demons, and then moving on to continue his work in other places and indeed to the ends of the earth. Mark's Gospel tells us that Jesus did this throughout Galilee.

Again Jesus' compassion and healing of the sick reassures us of the true purpose of the Kingdom of God. Hence, the Church being the body of Christ continues to extend Christ's healing presence to others in its ministry to the sick. In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the Church prays for spiritual and physical healing, forgiveness of sins, and comfort for those who are suffering from illness.

Therefore, brothers and sisters, we too, as members of the body of Christ, as disciples of Jesus, are called to be people on a mission, to be men and women for others. We are also called to preach. As St Paul tells us in the Second Reading, preaching the Gospel is a duty that has been laid upon us. Most importantly, we must preach this Gospel with love and compassion.

Finally, as we receive our sacramental healing and nourishment through the Eucharist today, may we join with Archbishop Mark Coleridge who delivers a homily this weekend to pray and "Call to all Catholics" initiative, offering a point of engagement for Catholics who do not regularly frequent our Church. So that all may return home.

## A NOTE FROM THE KNIGHTS OF THE SOUTHERN CROSS

Despite the frustrations of Covid19 during 2020, the  
parish's Knights of the Southern Cross (Br 90) donated:
