### Easter Blessings!

I am writing this just a short while after watching the 9am news and the Queensland Premier's announcement of the end of lockdown, and so our ability to gather to celebrate Easter this year: Good News, indeed! It has been somewhat of a tense week across the board for everyone, especially in dealing with the unknown. That is, not only for those of us who are looking forward to gathering to celebrate Christ Risen, but all who have been dealing with the pressures of the lockdown and its consequences. I am also keeping in mind, heart and prayer those who will continue to be restricted by the lockdown, especially those of our community in aged care and their families who are unable to visit them. Also those around our world who will be unable to gather to celebrate their faith in the Risen Christ.

There have been significant challenges for us in the past twelve months or so. One that has been highlighted for me is how we need to be careful with and for each other. While this has been and is, in a sense, something we might always be aware of, and are for each other, I venture that it has been highlighted in new ways for us and for our world in the past twelve months. I thought of this particularly last week when I was listening to Fr John Chalmers at our Clergy Convocation. In his talk on Exercising Pastoral Leadership. He spoke to the purpose of the Church as this was set out at the Second Vatican Council. The Council says that "the Church's constant task is to uncover, cherish and ennoble all that is true, good and beautiful in the human community." And, "inspired by no earthly ambition, the Church seeks a solitary goal, to carry forward the work of Christ himself under the lead of the befriending Spirit."

Jesus always cared for and was careful of others. He is the living Word of God, and this Word is the ultimate Care for all that exists. From the beginning God cares so much that all is carefully created, and ultimately cares so much that God sends his Son that we might be brought to life eternally. In the power of the Spirit Jesus brought healing and indeed mended a broken world through his life, death and resurrection. We have brought to life in Jesus Christ through the vitality of the Spirit in our baptism, and are called forth as the Church to be the body of Christ in for our world. We then, as the Council instructs us, are those in our world who are careful of other and our whole world; we are here to uncover, cherish and ennoble all that is true, good and beautiful in our community, and in our world.

As we celebrate this Easter and we reflect on how we are the Light of Christ for others, we might ponder how we might be more and more care-full of each and our world, and how we might enable this carefulness in our part of the world, our parish, in the coming year.

Thank you for being a people who care.
