I will not leave you orphans! (John 14:16)

After the resurrection, while Jesus was about to ascend to his Father in heaven, he looked at his disciples' face and seeing that they were going to miss him, he said "I will not leave you orphans, but will ask my father to send you another advocate (priest) to guide you and to remind you all that I have thought you". As I continue my priestly ministry as the parish priest of St May's Maryborough, I must say I owe a great deal of appreciation to all of you, especially to my ever-humble former lecturer, friend and mentor, Fr David Pascoe for giving me all the love and support needed for me to flourish. He is without doubt, my Aussie big brother and I owe him a great deal of gratitude.
