### Classroom Teaching of Religion

The teaching of Religion at St. Peter's School remains a priority at our school, as it is our Catholic Identity that makes up distinctive and unique. In each cycle of learning the children explore an inquiry question to help guide their learning and deepen their understanding of a particular strand; those being, Sacred Texts, Beliefs, Church, and Christian Life. Here are some of the inquiry questions being explored by our children at the moment:

Prep – How can I be more like Jesus?

Year 1 – What can we learn from Mary through stories and prayer?

Year 2 – How can the wisdom of the saints nurture our relationship with God, others and all creation?

Year 3 – What do the key stories from the Torah express about God's presence and action in daily life?

Year 4 – How does the wisdom of St Paul help people understand about living in a community?

Year 5 – What do the texts reveal about Mary as a woman of faith? How could communities be strengthened through the example of Mary?

Year 6 – How are the seasons of the Catholic Church organised?

### The Letter – the Movie

In 2015, Pope Francis wrote *Laudato Si'* (The Letter); an encyclical letter about the environmental crisis to every single person in the world. A few years later, four voices that have gone unheard in global conversations have been invited to an unprecedented dialogue with the Pope. Hailing from Senegal, the Amazon, India, and Hawai'i, they bring perspective and solutions from the poor, the indigenous, the youth, and wildlife into a conversation with Pope Francis himself. This documentary follows their journey to Rome and the extraordinary experiences that took place there, and is packed with powerfully moving personal stories alongside the latest information about the planetary crisis and the toll it's taking on nature and people.
