REJOICE IN THE LORD ALWAYS!

A man called his friend and said: I am in need of money; my mother is ill and I have no money for medicine. His friend thought something and said "Okay brother, don't worry." But when he called his friend in the evening, the phone was switched off. He tried calling again and again, but found the phone switched off. Feeling sad, he started thinking that when he needed it the most, his friend switched off his phone. When he returned home dejected, he saw a bag full of medicine on the table. He asked his wife "who had brought it?" The wife replied "your friend had come to take the prescription written by the doctor and he had also brought these medicines." At this, tears of happiness came to his eyes. He called his friend, but the phone was still switched off. Next day early in the morning he went to his friend's house and he said, "I have been calling you for so long, but the phone is continuously switched off." His friend said: "friend, I didn't have money, so I sold my phone and bought medicine for my mother. Your mother is my mother too." The purpose of Christmas is never fulfilled without helping the needy. The real joy of Christmas lies in giving, not in receiving.

The third Sunday of Advent is known as "Gaudete Sunday". The Latin word gaudete means to Rejoice. This is the call given by St. Paul in the reading "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice". That's why the third candle in the Advent wreath symbolizes Joy reminding us of the joy that would be ours at the Lord's coming at Christmas. And this is what the Angels announced at the birth of Christ "Behold, I bring you good news of great Joy" *LK 2:10*

We need to understand that the JOY of Christmas is different from the Happiness of Christmas. The elevated mood that results from cookies and cakes, Carols and Crib, Stars and decorations, dance and party, Santa Claus and Gifts, new cloths and holidays is not JOY but the happiness of the celebration of Christmas. We must not mistake Joy with Happiness. Happiness is something that results from external things. Joy is something that is an inner experience.

When our friends or family members visit us, we are filled with joy. How much more should we feel joyful to know that God is coming to visit us? It is precisely this joy that we must aim at. True JOY is the joy of receiving Jesus into our lives. Joy of Christ being born in our hearts. Joy of experiencing Emmanuel: God with us. The joy of knowing the immense Love and Mercy of God who comes to save us. Joy of being transformed persons to welcome Christ.

We must know the source of joy. We will never experience joy if we don't know where it comes from. True joy comes from God alone. He is the fullness of joy as Psalm 16:11 tells us. Our joy comes from and is found in Jesus. He is the source of all joy. And if the fullness of joy is found in His presence, then the only place we should ever seek joy is in Him. Let's remember it is SIN which is the cause of sadness, and it is Jesus who is the cause of our joy. Let us then cast away sin and cling on to Jesus then our sadness will turn into joy.
